GROUPS DISTRIBUTION

Face-to-face instruction has been classified in different types:

1/ Clases expositivas (**CEX**): This term refers to the lectures.

2/ Seminarios (**SEM**): Translated as seminars. Discussion activities or practices of a certain topic will be carried out in this type of classes. Students' participation is crucial.

3/ Prácticas de laboratorio (**PLA**): Practical activities carried out in the computer lab. Students may work both individually or in groups.

4/ Tutorías grupales (**TG**): Group tutorials. Scheduled activities where the lecturer works with a small number of students in order to guide them in their autonomous work.

PAR/IMPAR DIVISION

Weeks are divided in PAR or IMPAR.

1/ PAR: Refers to even weeks.

2/ IMPAR: Refers to odd weeks.

This division is made as follows: The first week of the course or semester would be week number 1 (odd), the next, would be week number 2 (even) and so on and so forth.

Course Selection and Procedure

• Full-year Exchange: 60 ECTS

• Half-Year Exchange: 30 ECTS

Modules will be chosen prior to student arrival.

Students will be given a university username and password and will have to register on-line during or prior to induction week.

Exchange students are free to join any modules listed in the handbook for which they are qualified and have endorsement from their home university.

No direct payment for tuition fees is normally made, due to reciprocal exchange agreements.

An official academic diploma supplement will be issued to your home institution at the end of your study, listing modules, grades and credits awarded.

PHILOLOGICAL AND LANGUAGE COURSES

Language of Instruction: the language of study of the course (Asturian, English, French, German, Italian, Portuguese). Most modules will be taught in their original language.

The philological and language courses are structured into a Major and a Minor, so that students need to take 240 ECTS credits in order to obtain the Bachelor Degree. These 240 credits are distributed as follows:

1st YEAR	60 ECTS credits	Basic subjects (6 common + 4 specific)
2nd YEAR	60 ECTS credits	Major + Minor (7 + 3)
3rd YEAR	60 ECTS credits	Major + Minor (7 + 3)
4th YEAR	60 ECTS credits	Major + Minor (6 + 2 + internship + Final degree dissertation)
